Amendments to MCYS Sailing Instructions for the MCYS-RMYS race 11/02/2023:

- 1. The Time Limit shall be amended to 1700 hrs on 11/2/2023 yachts finishing after that time will be scored DNF.
- 2. SAILSYS-PHS and AMS and ORC handicapping shall be used if sufficient entries are received.

ALL VESSELS participating in the Cruise or Race must **keep clear of all commercial vessels and shipping** and give way where necessary. **VESSELS** should not cross commercial shipping channels where such crossing would interfere with the passage of commercial shipping or be so close as to cause concern for commercial shipping.

12 or 13 February - Return at your own pace to MCYS.
